This oral medication is the first and only kinase inhibitor approved to treat IPF.

Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is a chronic and fatal lung disease that has no known cure. There are over 130,000 Americans diagnosed with this rare disease that causes scar tissue to develop in the lungs and progressively decreases functioning.
